CONCESSIONAL LICENSING (Code 404)

REPORT TO GENERAL MEETING

As you are aware on 17th October last year I sent an email to the Department of Transport requesting the following:

1. Clarification as to whether or not the conditions of use for concessionally licensed vehicles are relaxed for the National Motoring Heritage Day and for Anzac Day, effectively allowing normal use on those days; and
2. Acknowledgment that although the CMC is not an authorised historic motor vehicle club in its own right, it can host and organise events involving concessionally licensed vehicles.

On 7th February I received the following response from DoT to our queries:

1. There are no special arrangements on the NMHD or Anzac Day. If vehicles are to be used on those days it must be in accordance with the current rules and conditions contained in the Code 404 Information Booklet. So a club event would need to be in place.
2. The department recognises the CMC's ability to host and organise events for concessionally licensed vehicles

provided such vehicles are participating as part of club events.
